CARBONDALE, Ill. -- A Southern Illinois University Carbondale zoology graduate student is the recipient of a two-year, \$3,000 fellowship from the Illinois-Indiana Sea Grant College Program.

April A. Robinson of Carbondale is a student in Michael J. Lydy's aquatic toxicology lab in the University's Fisheries and Illinois Aquaculture Center. Her research focuses on "Toxicity of fluoroquinolone antibiotics to aquatic organisms."

The University of Illinois and Purdue University cooperatively administer Sea Grant Illinois-Indiana, which focuses on marine research and the sustainable development of coastal resources along southern Lake Michigan and in the Great Lakes Region.
